May use natural forest wood or other materials to produce/create features or other decorative items. Utilizes hand tools and operates vehicles and powered equipment including but not limited to, mini-excavators, backhoes, mini-screens, bobcats, boxer chippers, and other equipment to perform landscaping and ground maintenance work.
